Extra Information:

- Your child should be present when their bag/case is packed so they know what clothes are theirs
- Everybody needs to bring a warm, waterproof coat
- Children should bring suitable footwear as there is a reasonable amount of walking during the trip
- There is no need for a sleeping bag as the centre provides quilts, however sending a familiar pillow with your child is a very good idea and aids sleep
- Everybody will need a TOWEL
- A packed lunch is required for the Wednesday
- When placing NUT FREE sweets/ biscuits/ chocolates in your child's bag, you should ask yourself whether you would be happy for them to eat that amount over two days if they were at home
- As we will be eating lunch and taking part in activities before getting to our rooms at the centre, we ask if the packed lunch and coat would not be packed in the case but are taken separately on the bus. As we will be visiting the Big Pit first, the children should wear appropriate clothes on the first morning for an underground tour of the coal mine (warm clothing and sturdy shoes - no sandals or white canvas shoes)
- £15 is the maximum pocket money we would expect. Some of this should be sent in £1 coins as change is needed for the swimming pool lockers and the vending machines
- No phones or cameras allowed - Miss Thomas will take pictures and will have the school mobile (07745240035)
- Electronics are allowed for the bus journey only - they will be taken from the children when we arrive at the centre and placed in the safe.
